The St Ninian Declaration

The signing of the Saint Ninian Declaration between the Scottish Episcopal Church and the Catholic Church in Scotland will take place in Edinburgh on Tuesday 16 September 2025 – the Feast of St Ninian.

The Declaration supports a deepening relationship between Episcopalians and Roman Catholics in Scotland, allowing both to work more closely together while acknowledging that there are distinct differences between the two churches. The historic declaration of friendship will be signed at the capital's two 'St Mary's' cathedrals. The first part of the signing will take place at St Mary's Catholic Cathedral in York Place, and the second part at St Mary's Episcopal Cathedral in Palmerston Place.

Dear friends,

As I write, I have just returned from my Southern Tour—thirteen churches in three days, travelling through the beautiful and varied landscapes of Galloway. In every charge, I found the same deep love for Christ and commitment to serving the communities we are called to bless.

One highlight was the special service in New Galloway for the appointment of the Rev Dr Elizabeth Breakey as Rural Dean. This role will give the south of our Diocese a stronger voice, recognising that each part of Glasgow and Galloway has its own unique gifts to offer. We are not called to be identical, but to be "together"—a body where difference enriches, rather than divides.

In Mark 10:17–31, which we had at Elizabeth's service, Jesus speaks to a man who longs to inherit eternal life. He is invited to lay down what he treasures most and follow. The road of discipleship is never simply about preserving what we have; it is also about letting go, trusting God, and discovering that we are richer together than we could ever be alone.

Last month a small group enjoyed making wreaths and made a donation to Médecins sans Frontières [MSF UK] who are working in Gaza.


